Charge of the Student Assignment Advisory Committee

1. Alternative K-5 Assignment Plans will be developed by the new Student Assignment Advisory Committee for the 2001 – 2002 school year and beyond for consideration by the Board no later than the second meeting in November 2000:
 - a. A plan with multiple factors that includes the use of race.
 - b. A plan with factors excluding the use of race
2. Committee formation and process will adhere to the following guidelines:
 - a. The committee will include parent representation from each of the affected elementary K-5 schools.
 - b. The committee will develop the alternative student assignment plans by October 31, 2000.
 - c. There will be at least one community forum.
3. In receiving its charge, the Committee will be provided with all relevant law affecting the legal parameters within which the committee must make its recommendations so as to comply with existing law.
4. The schools will be queried about the recommended plans.
